The Current Situation

- Most Takaful Operators are small and under capitalised and have focused on Personal Lines and Life
- Domestic Markets have inconsistent regulatory and legal frameworks
- ► There is too much reliance upon ceding commissions and not enough focus on underwriting profits from retention of risk most act like brokers
- ► Facultative reinsurance for commercial exposure is inefficiently purchased and mainly comes from the conventional market
- Takaful's are not confident enough to compete on merit with their conventional counterparts and therefore tend to under-price risk
- ► There is too little local expertise to go around

How might things be improved?

- Local insurers should cooperate with international markets such as London in order to build a viable and sustainable insurance industry in the MENA region.
 - Development of shared expertise
 - Security & Trust
 - A profitable outcome for all
- ► Takaful insurers should attempt to put themselves on a similar economic footing to conventional counterparts
 - ► No significant business will be done with unrated counterparties
 - Solvency and other Regulations will drive change
 - Consolidation
- Press regulators to stop the artificial separation of Takaful from the conventional sector in order to ensure best practice whatever the product
- Use the strengths of the model to provide innovative products in a way which are fully inclusive
